What is Peat?

Peat is basically decomposed organic plant matter that can be found in water-saturated environments.

How is Peat used in the distilling process?

Burning peat is used to dry the malted barley, stopping the germination process.

What is the difference between Peated and Unpeated Whisky?

Whisky can be classified into two main flavours: peated (smoky) and unpeated (non-smoky). Essentially, the malt for an unpeated whisky is dried with hot air without any smoke.
